## **Note on Policy:**

**Students may only be granted permission to resubmit a flawed film to screenings for 1 hour beyond the formal signup end time (usually noon):**

A technical error amnesty period of 1 hour is permitted for students who have uploaded a file prior to the noon deadline but subsequently note technical issues with the file. The legitimate technical issue must be fully explained and a form must be signed by David Long by 1:00 p.m. after the formal signup time ends. An agreement on appropriate time needed to resolve the technical issue in question will be made between FVASA, David, and the student (the corrected file need not necessarily be submitted by 1:00 p.m.). FVASA will confirm that replacement media submitted by the student corrects the technical error originally claimed and nothing more. This policy applies only to students who have submitted at least one version of their film on time. Originally late submissions due to technical error must be petitioned through the existing policy and Malcolm Spaul.
