

# Pre-College Portfolio Preparation Workshop

## Program Overview

RIT's School of Art has re-envisioned its Pre-College Portfolio Preparation Workshop this year to offer an engaging and rewarding experience in a virtual environment for rising high school juniors and seniors.

Over the course of two weeks, students will create still-life drawings, gesture drawings of the figure and explore techniques for drawing the human head. RIT faculty will be showing demonstration videos, detailed step-by-step slide shows, conducting live demonstrations and both group and individual critiques. Participants will have the opportunity to focus more on drawing of the human figure and still-life drawings. Students will also create self-portraits. A preliminary schedule will be distributed to participants but is subject to change.

The two-week workshop will take place from Monday, July 12 to Friday, July 23, 2021. The workshop will be offered via Zoom and taught by RIT drawing and painting faculty. The classes will run daily from 10 am to 12 pm and 1 pm to 3 pm EST Monday through Friday with the opportunity for additional times as needed. Art supplies will be mailed to student participants prior to the start of the workshop.

The cost for the workshop is \$750. Once we receive your application, a link to the online payment portal will be sent. Scholarships to cover the cost of the workshop are available, but limited. If interested, please review the Scholarship Section of the application, seen on page three. Scholarship applications are due by June 1, 2021 and applicants will receive a decision by June 15, 2021.

### Scholarship Requirements

#### 1) Statement of Intent

Scholarship applicants must submit a 300-500 word statement answering the following prompts:

- Why do you want to attend the Pre-College Portfolio Preparation Workshop?
- What do you hope to accomplish by attending this workshop?

#### 2) Three Examples of Student Work

Students must submit three samples of original student work for scholarship consideration. These may include, but are not limited to, original drawings or sketches, digital creations, and/or craft or material pieces. Digital copies or photographs may be submitted rather than original artwork. Submissions may be sent digitally to the School of Art at [art@rit.edu](mailto:art@rit.edu) (please label attachments with student name, file sizes may not exceed 10MB) or by mail to the address listed on the first page of this application. Please note that any original submissions are not guaranteed to be returned.
