#### ✓ ID Cards - ACTION ITEM

### ✓ University ID # - ACTION ITEM

Your university ID # is needed for all forms your submit. Please memorize it. To find your UID, log into your SIS account and click on Personal Information, you will see your ID # at the top left corner of your screen, between the orange bar and personal details.

### ✓ RIT Email - ACTION ITEM

#### ✓ Textbooks - ACTION ITEM

To see your textbook list by class, you can visit the RIT Online Bookstore

#### ✓ Immunizations - ACTION ITEM

## ✓ Student Financial Responsibility Agreement (SFRA) - ACTION ITEM

The SFRA is a mandatory agreement that outlines financial obligations and responsibilities for attendance at RIT. All students must complete the SFRA via their SIS student portal on the task tile. The SFRA must be accepted in order to continue to access university services, including enrollment, as an active student.

- A term-by-term breakdown of the degree requirements for your program (curriculum).
- Emailed to you when you start your program; your advisor can send you a pdf copy upon request.
